1. Use the QR Codes to donate via ActBlue or Venmo.
2. Write a check payable to "SD40 DFL" and **hand it in** today or **mail** it to:

3. Whichever option you choose for donating, we will need your full name and address. SD40 DFL will mail you a receipt and the proper form to send to the Minnesota Department of Revenue.
4. Send in your receipt(s) and form to the MN Department of Revenue. You will receive your refund in about six weeks.

Guide to Convention Procedure/Robert's Rules

To speak, make a motion, or ask a question, go to a microphone, introduce yourself and give your precinct name/number.

If You Want to:	You Say:	Debate:	Vote:
Bring business before convention	"I move that/to..."	Yes	Majority
Modify wording of a motion/document	"I move to amend..." (state amendment)	Yes	Majority
Raise an issue about procedures or rules	"Point of personal privilege..."	No	None
Ask a question (but not as a form of debate)	"Point of clarification..."	No	None
Kill the motion on the floor	"I move to table... (state motion)"	Yes	Majority
Perform an action not allowed by the rules	"I move to suspend the rules to..."	No	2/3
Demand a voice vote be counted	"I call for division."	No	None
End discussion/debate (aka "calling the question")	"I move to end debate" or "I move the previous question".	No	2/3
